This post carries a salary scale of HM 2-1 Rs. 91,645 – 12x2,700 – 124,045/- subject to Management Services Department Circular No. 2/2016 (I). Full salary scale will be given in year 2020 initial salary step for the year 2017 is Rs. 63,076/-. The post is permanent, with entitlement to ‘Employees Provident Fund and Employees Trust Fund’. This position is entitled to other benefits and allowances commensurate with similar posts in the State Sector.

(2) A Bachelor degree in Sociology/ Psychology/ Mass Communication/ Management/ Social Work/ Law/ Commerce/ Chemistry/ Accountancy/ Information Technology/ Statistics, which is recognized by the University Grants Commission.

PhD which is recognized by the University Grants Commission.

At least 05 years experience at Senior Managerial Level in a Corporation/Statutory Board/Institution level in a Corporation/ Statutory Board or a reputed private institution after obtaining PhD, and posses an excellent service record.
