#### **Training of Law Enforcement Officers**

The main purpose of the PEI unit mission to law enforcement officers training was to point the relationship between law enforcement agencies and NDDCB for proper drugs training for law enforcement officers and to conduct education program on knowledge sharing basis. In this period, PEI unit gave their assistance to the Treatment and Rehabilitation Unit by providing lectures on preventive education and counseling to the organized workshop for proposed rehabilitation camp at Kandakadu.

The best form of the dealing with the problem is both reducing supply and demand for drugs. PEI unit is increasing the assistance to law enforcement officers at supply reduction mechanisms, and the Unit work closely with law enforcement agencies so that they can reach the drug traffickers and smugglers before they join with small peddlers.

The PEI unit believes that greater attention and more resource should be invested in drug supply reduction programs aim at preventing the spared of pressers. Hundred of were trained during the commanding period on Drugs Law and drug identification through several workshops, the details of which are as follows.

#### **Health Services Officers**

Education and Training programs are necessary to reach the many health service officers who are not in contact with drug prevention, treatment or rehabilitation knowledge. Of these participants, 07 were trained during the reporting period on prevention education through single training programs. Subsequent evaluation has been indicated that the motivation for their optimistic drug reduce objective is very high.
